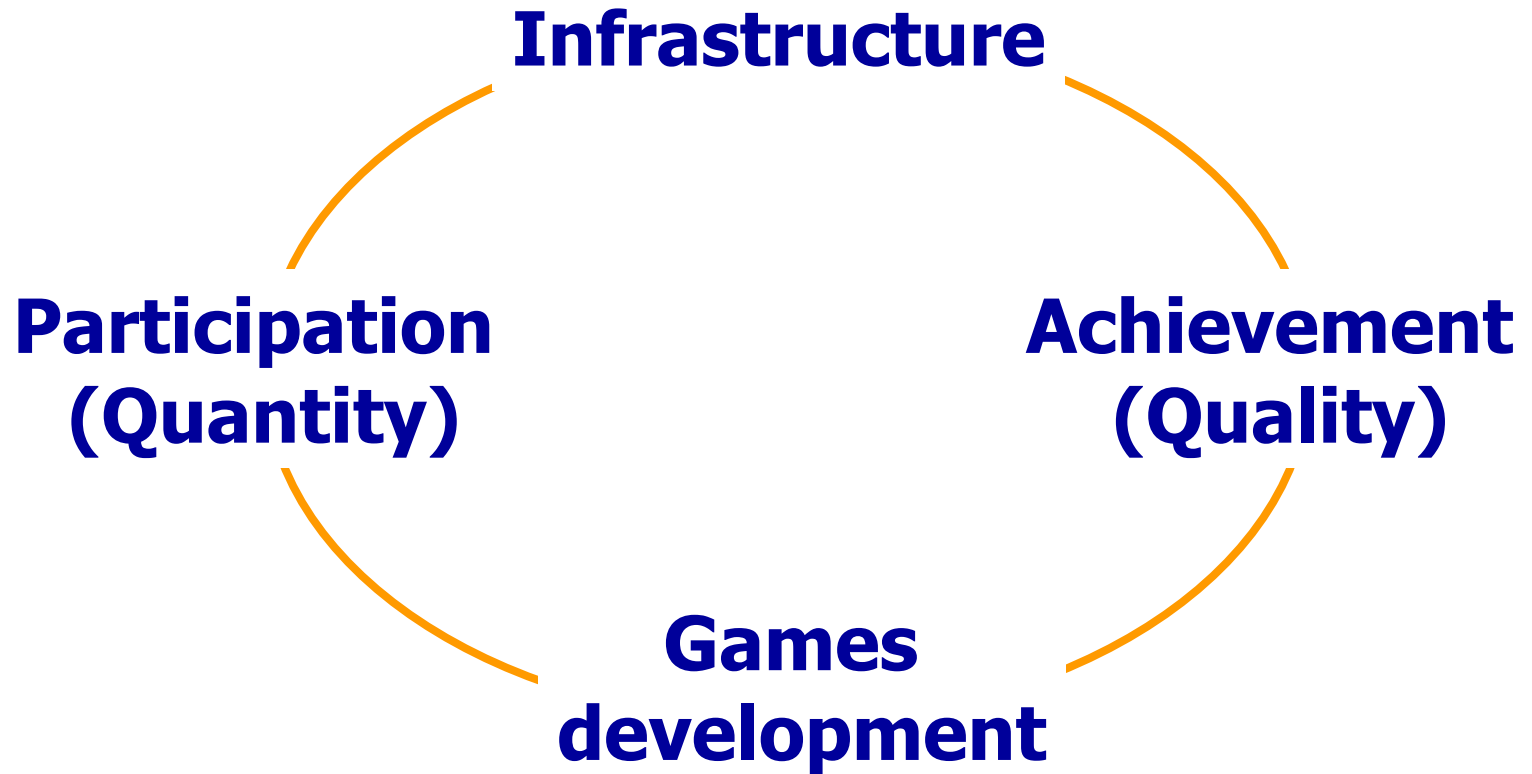

Where Do Our Priorities lie?

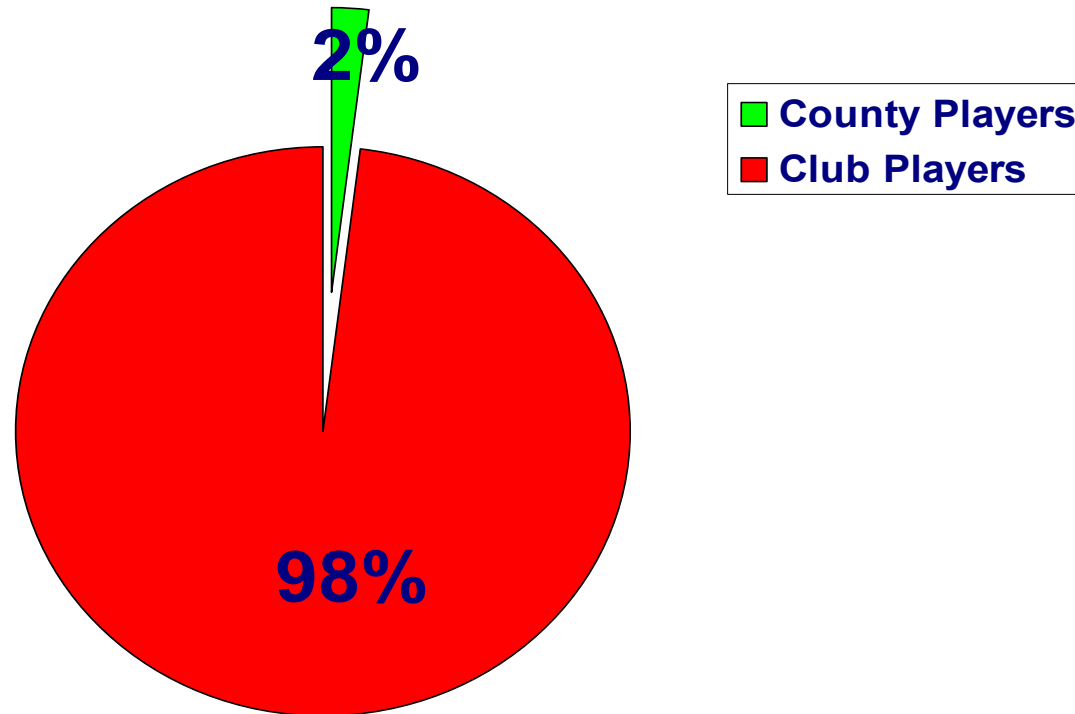


Some Home Truths

More Home Truths

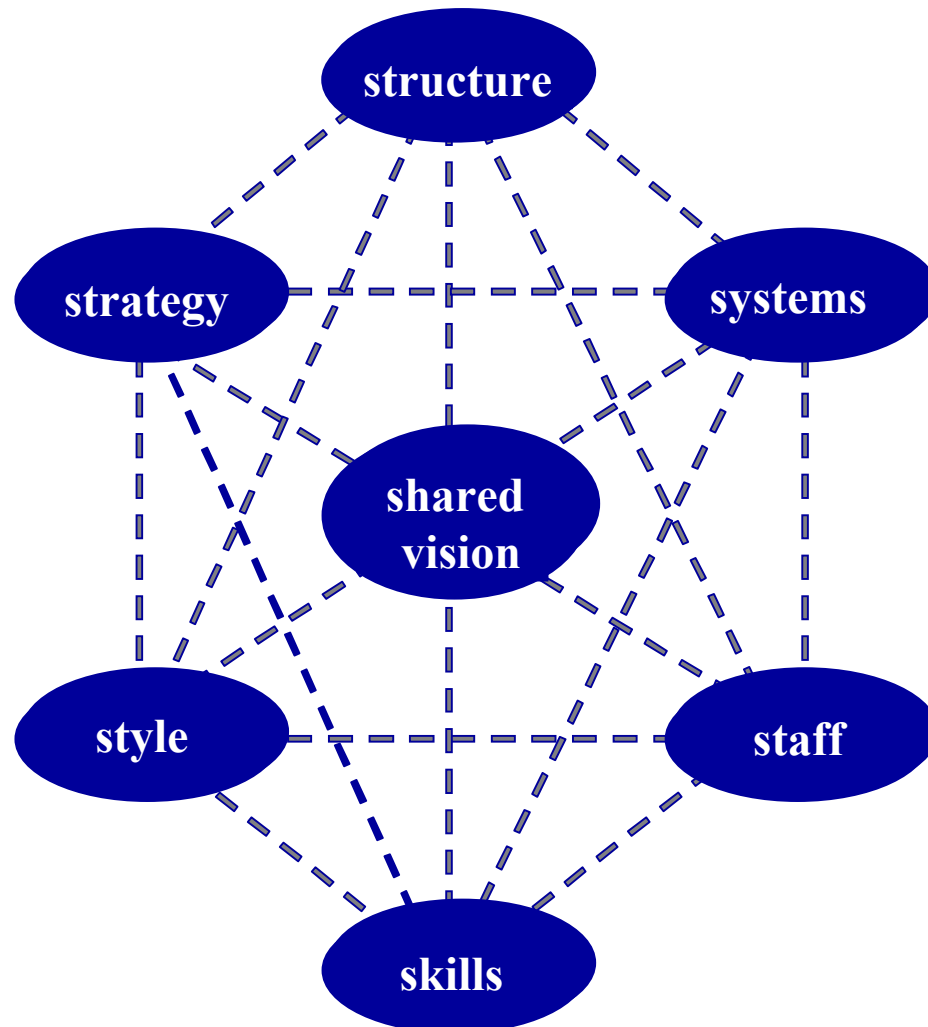
County players account for 2% of our player population ... Club players for 98%
